


Did You Know?????

Highlights about your school

- ***The Buffalo Business Review ranked the Greenwich High School Social Studies Department in the top 3% of all upstate New York school districts.***
- ***The Buffalo Business Review ranked the Greenwich Central School ELA department in the top 12% in upstate. The GCS Science department was ranked in the top 19% and the Math department was ranked in the top 16% of all upstate New York school districts.***
- ***45% of all of the Regents exams taken in Greenwich in June 2017 were scored at Mastery level!***
- ***84% of the class of 2016 took at least 1 college level/AP course before graduating***
- ***GCS AP students outperformed the U.S. and Global averages in all 10 of the AP courses taught at Greenwich last year.***



Last year approximately 80% of the students in Greenwich Junior-Senior High School were involved in at least one extra-curricular and/or co-curricular activity. These activities include clubs, athletic teams, the theater program, and the performing arts programs.

How does our athletic program Compare to the rest of New York?

The New York State Sports Writers Association has ranked the Greenwich Athletic program as one of the best “Class C” sports programs in New York State during 6 of the last 9 years.

Since 2008-09, Greenwich Varsity teams have placed either 1st or 2nd in Section II fifty-eight times (7 teams finished in the top 2 of sectionals last year!).

Over the past seven years at least one athlete from GCS has earned at least a partial athletic scholarship to a Division I college or university.
