

NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY SELECTION PROCESS

- SPRING:** NHS Advisors/School Counselors/Current NHS members go into 10th and 11th grade classes and provide an overview of what NHS is and the process that is used for selection
- EARLY JULY:** The Counseling Office will generate list of students who have earned an 89.5% or better GPA in grades 10 and 11 and therefore are eligible to apply for consideration for entry into NHS
- A letter will be sent to all academically eligible students in grades 10 and 11 asking the students to confirm that they want to pursue the application process for NHS. Students will be required to affirm or deny their intent in writing.
- JULY-AUGUST:** The NHS advisors will send a list of academically eligible students to the building administration. The building administrators will review list and identify any individuals that have significant behavioral referrals in their disciplinary file. Any student with significant disciplinary referrals will be referred to the previous year's NHS faculty council for review. The Faculty Council will decide whether candidate should continue in application process.
- AUGUST:** A letter along with a copy of the NHS Student Application form will be sent to eligible students.
- New faculty council will be selected by the Principal.
- SEPTEMBER:** The JSBS faculty will rate candidates on character at a faculty meeting.
- The Faculty Council will evaluate/rate applications and develop the list of those candidates that have been selected for entry, as well as the list of those that have not gained entry
- The NHS advisor(s) will send a letter all applicants notifying them of the Faculty Council's decisions.
- Students selected for entry will be asked to provide a short biography to the NHS to be used at the induction ceremony.

OCTOBER: Induction ceremony will take place.
